

1978 Lotus Eclat

- Produced 1975 - 1982, The Lotus Eclat was a fastback version of the new Elite
- Engine: Lotus 907 1973cc 4cyl , DOHC 16-valve
Power :160 bhp @ 6200 rpm
Torque: 140 lb ft @ 4900 rpm
Gearbox: Lotus 5-speed
Chassis Body Construction: Steel backbone chassis with glassfibre reinforced plastic body.
