

M.G.CAR CLUB 'Y' TYPE REGISTER

DIAMOND JUBILEE & 10th ANNUAL SPRING RUN Sunday 13th May 2007

On **Sunday 13th May 2007** the M.G. Car Club `Y' Type Register will be holding the Diamond Jubilee to celebrate 60 years since the launch of the M.G. Y Series. This will take place at Charlecote Park, nr Stratford upon Avon, Warwickshire. This unique event, which will also include an optional Spring Run, also marks the beginning of hopefully a number of activities to be held in 2007 to celebrate 60 years of the Y.

Charlecote Park, is a National Trust property that includes a superb Tudor house and landscaped deer park. Described in the NT 2006 Handbook as: `The home of the Lucy family for over 700 years, the mellow brickwork and great chimneys of Charlecote seem to sum up the very essence of Tudor England. There are strong associations with both Queen Elizabeth and Shakespeare, who knew the house well – he is alleged to have been caught poaching the estate deer. The rich early Victorian interior contains many important objects from Beckford's Fonthill Abbey and, outside, the balustraded formal garden opens onto a fine deer park.' The facilities include an excellent Orangery (licensed) with hot meals available between 12.00-2.30 and teas from 10.30 -5.00. Although the NT charges for entry into the house and grounds they have agreed a discounted rate for us of £6.90 per person, with children under 16 free. NT members of course have free entry as usual.

Charlecote is located 6 miles south of Warwick (approximately 4 miles from Junction 15 of the M40) and 5 miles east of Stratford-upon-Avon. (See OS Map 151- Grid Ref: SP263564).

The Gates will be open for us from 10.00 am and the event will include a short run of around 35 miles around the Warwickshire countryside. This is not obligatory and some may wish to take the opportunity to remain at Charlecote to discuss Y matters with others present, renew old friendships and make new ones. It is anticipated that the run will commence around 11.45 am and we would ask all participants to return by 2.45 pm at the latest. At 3.45 pm awards will be made following a self-judging `concours' and will be divided into three categories – YA, YT and YB. The Register will have a stand and if you require parts to collect then please contact David Hague on 01730 266362 or e-mail regalia@mgytypes.org.

We are **NOT** charging Y Type owners for the event but would ask you to include an **A4 self** addressed envelope with your application with stamps to the value of 90p (1st Class) to cover the cost of sending out your rally board and route book.
