The **MGB Register** is pleased to announce an MGB Gathering , **all models of MG welcome** , the first 50 classic MG's registered before 1980 will be allocated a special parking permit to park on Millennium Place , up to another 30 entrants not qualifying for parking on Millennium Place can park free in the museum staff car park.

The event will take place on Sunday the 3rd October 2010 at the Coventry Motor Museum , the Museum opens at 10.00 and those MG's allocated a parking place on Millennium Place must arrive between 10.00 and 11.00 and must comply with the conditions related to the parking permit (see below) .

Entry to the event and the Museum is **FREE** , but if you intend to come please contact Bernard Rengger on 01858 431271(total entry is limited to 80 cars) . To obtain your special parking permit all you have to do is to send a stamped address envelope to Bernard Rengger , Conifers 18A Main Street , Sutton Bassett LE16 8HP together with your name and address and details of the MG you will be driving (model and year).Your permit and instruction on how to get to the museum will be sent by return.

Conditions related to parking on Millennium Place

1. You must obtain and display a parking permit
2. You must bring with you AND USE a suitable drip tray .
3. You must accept responsibility for any drips not caught by the drip tray and clear these up before you leave.
4. You must arrive between 10.00 and 11.00 and follow the parking marshals instructions whilst driving on to and off Millennium Place

This promises to be a grand day out as the Museum is right in the heart of Coventry has some catering facilities and houses the largest collection of British road transport anywhere in the world including Thrust 2 the current world Land speed record holder.
