

THE ROYAL WINDSOR MG HERITAGE FESTIVAL CHARITY ROAD RUNS 25TH APRIL 2009

A prestigious and unique event is taking place in MG's 85th Anniversary year.

The MG Owners' Club has been invited by the Rotary Club of Windsor and Eton to spearhead a weekend of activities which include a Royal Review of MG Cavalcade and other events that will raise substantial sums for the Prince Philip Trust Fund and Rotary nominated Charities.

In addition to the Royal Review, we have planned multi-start point scenic road runs for other MG Owners who wish to become involved in this unique event in a more modest way. In association with the MG Car Club, MG Octagon Car Club and the Early MG Society we are calling on each Club's membership to help support the fundraising road runs. These organised runs will all start within a 80-90 mile radius of Windsor Great Park and culminate in an exclusive scenic drive through the private grounds of Windsor Great Park converging on a designated parking area on the "Long Walk" drive just below the Copper Horse monument. We aim to see 1000 MGs of all types lining the drive which is set against the stunning backdrop of Windsor Castle. The entry fee of £25 (which can be gift aided direct to the charity fund) will include full tulip diagram route, a commemorative rally board and radiator grille badge, a 52 page souvenir brochure which will also allow entry to the Frogmore Parade Ground adjacent to Windsor Castle, where 300 Cavalcade MGs will be on display following the Royal Review.

Each start venue will be strictly limited to 100 cars so please **return your entry form below to: MG Owners' Club, Octagon House, 1 Over Road, Swavesey, Cambridge, CB24 4QZ** soon as possible. All entries will be on a first come first served basis, in the event of your chosen venue being oversubscribed we will contact you to offer an alternative or a full refund will be made. In order to maximise the full benefit for the Charity funds, UK tax payers can pay the entry fee of £25 as a gift aid donation, so please also sign the declaration part of the entry form to allow Rotary Club of Windsor and Eton to claim an additional 20% from HM Revenue & Customs. Cheques for £25.00 should be made payable to The Rotary Club of Windsor & Eton. All joining instructions will be sent to the entrants 2 weeks before the event and the rally pack will distributed when signing on at the start venue.
