Whittington is situated off the A51 Lichfield to Tamworth road and the pub is located on the cross roads in the centre of the village.

The run of approximately 60 miles will pass through scenic countryside in Staffordshire, Warwickshire and Oxfordshire finishing at Upton House a National Trust Property close to Banbury. The house which was owned by the family who founded the Shell Oil Company, is very interesting, with fine furnishings, a 1930s House Party display, a beautiful garden, a renowned art collection and a Shell advertisement museum display.

Our cars will be parked up on the drive, in front of the main entrance to the house, for all visitors to inspect. The NT are sensitive to oil leaks on the drive so if there is the slightest risk of a leak from your precious car will you please bring and use a leak tray, cardboard or similar !! Thanks.

We have managed to arrange a 2 for 1 entrance fee to the house and gardens for non NT members.

There is a charge of £10.00 per car for the run which will be donated to our nominated Charity, the Donna Louise Trust, a Children's Hospice.
